The general responsibility of the NSCFRMC is to oversee the preparation of Floodplain Management Studies and Plans for the Narrabri Shire. The NSCFRMC acts as both a focus and forum for the discussion of technical, social, economic, environmental matters and for the distillation of possibly differing viewpoints on these matters into a management plan. The NSCFRMC is tasked with seeking solutions to the existing, future and continuing flood risk issues, not solely on addressing the past.
