

## PUBLIC EXHIBITION

### Full Suite of Draft Strategic Documents

Pursuant of the NSW Local Government Act 1993, Council advises the Narrabri Shire that the full suite of draft strategic documents are now on public exhibition from Wednesday, 17 May 2017 until Thursday, 15 June 2017. The full suite of draft strategic documents includes:

- Draft 2017 – 2027 Community Strategic Plan,
- Draft 2017 – 2021 Delivery Program,
- Draft 2017 – 2021 Resourcing Strategy,
- Draft 2017 – 2018 Operational Plan and
- Draft 2017 – 2021 Disability Inclusion Action Plan.

Placing draft strategic documents on public exhibition provides our community with the opportunity to review each document in detail and provide feedback to Council on the future direction of our Shire.

Members of the public may view draft strategic documents at Council Libraries, Council's Administration Office, Council's website and the following specific locations:

Baan Baa Pub, Bellata Golf Club, Boggabri Book Exchange, Gwabegar Post Office and Pilliga Community Link Centre.

Written submissions will be received up until 5pm on Thursday, 15 June 2017 and should be addressed to the General Manager, Narrabri Shire Council, PO Box 261, Narrabri, NSW, 2390.

Prior to adopting draft strategic documents on Tuesday, 27 June 2017, Council will take into consideration any submissions that have been received.



Each week we will focus on one of the four themes from the Community Strategic Plan which feeds into the suite of strategic documents for Council. The objectives and strategies within the Community Strategic Plan were developed through the Think BIG community engagement process.

Through the community engagement process, our community identified several social priority areas to be addressed in the Community Strategic Plan. From this process, strategic objectives emerged and strategies were developed to achieve our overall strategic direction of *providing a safe, supportive community where everyone feels welcomed, valued and connected.*
