ENVIROSHIRE



This is one of the Residential Kerbside Waste loads that we receive at the landfill every week. As you can see it is full of materials that could have been recycled and re-used. This is a big problem which can reduce the lifetime of the landfill, increase the use of natural resources and increase contamination.

How you can help? You can help by recycling! Use your Yellow bin to place:

- **Aluminium cans** – drink cans

- **Steel cans** – tin food and spray cans including cooking oil spray cans.
- **Plastics** – all food containers eg. margarine, yoghurt, ice cream and water bottles up to 10 litres. Also any soft /fizzy drink bottles and milk bottles.
- **Clear pallet wrap** from businesses that receive pallets wrapped in a plastic film.
- **All paper and cardboard.**

Items we do not accept:

- We don't accept the foam meat trays that you would purchase meat on at supermarket or any other foam containers.
- No containers that have had any kind of oil with a petroleum base. Eg engine oil
- No shopping bags.
- No plastic film, such as glad wrap.
