

PARKING ENFORCEMENT

We aim to achieve a balance between public safety and traffic flow in the management of vehicle parking throughout the Narrabri Local Government Area.

Council conducts regular parking compliance operations in Narrabri CBD, to enforce parking regulations for the benefit of our residents, businesses and community visitors.

Examples of illegal parking where infringement notices will be issued include:

- Overstaying signposted time limits
- Parking where there are 'No Parking' or 'No Stopping' signs
- Parking on public reserves
- Parking across driveways
- Parking on nature strips or footpath
- Parking in disabled car parks without permit

Infringement notice types can include:

- Penalty Infringement Notices – including fines payable to Revenue NSW
- Vehicle impoundment

Benefits of smart CBD Parking:

- Supporting your own and other local businesses by increasing turnover of parking spaces for potential customers to shop and conduct business, especially as we approach the warmer months.
- Being considerate of our resident elderly, disabled and guardians with young child, making it easier for people to enjoy their time in the CBD.
- Increasing pedestrian and passenger safety in our CBD

Narrabri Shire Council is encouraging our local CBD business owners, staff and residents to think smart when they park in Narrabri's CBD.

Council receives regular complaints from residents and visitors regarding CBD business owners and employees parking in 2-hour limited CBD parking spaces. This document has been developed to create more awareness and encourage appropriate parking within Narrabri CBD for the benefit of local residents, visitors and businesses.

Council encourages businesses owners, staff and residents to follow parking regulations to support our local businesses and economy.

COUNCIL'S ROLE

Narrabri Shire Council manages parking restrictions on regional and local roads.

Designated parking areas and time restrictions are used to help regulate parking to ensure vacant spaces are available. Restrictions encourage:

- Making parking spaces more readily available for the elderly, people who are shopping, conducting business or visiting a doctor.
- Pedestrian safety
- Passenger safety during pick-up or drop-off
- Supporting local businesses and economy

WHERE CAN I PARK?

Narrabri Shire Council provides more than 400 car parking spaces in Narrabri's CBD centre, both on and off-street.

All Day Parking locations

- Tibbereena Street
- Barwon Street
- Carparks – TAFE Carpark, Crossing Theatre

2 Hour parking

- Located through CBD centre – Maitland, Bowen, Dewhurst, Doyle and Lloyd St

15-minute parking

- Various locations in Maitland and Tibbereena St

Caravan/Trailer Parking locations

- Narrabri Region Visitor Information Centre Carpark

While there are many car parks located in Narrabri's CBD centre, time restrictions apply throughout the CBD.

These aim to

- promote turnover of foot traffic
- make parking spaces more readily available for people who are:
 - elderly
 - shopping
 - conducting business
 - visiting a doctor or appointing, where the duration of the task is usually less than two hours.
 - traveling

Time restrictions operate from:

- 9.00am to 5.30pm Monday – Friday
- 9.00am to 12.00pm Saturday

Outside these times and on public holidays on-street parking time limits do not apply.

You should always check the information on the parking signs.

LONG STAY PARKING (MORE THAN TWO HOURS)

A number of free and untimed parking spaces are available in Narrabri CBD, with convenient pedestrian access to local businesses.

There is a requirement by some people to park for longer than two hours, usually by workers whose place of employment is in Narrabri's CBD centre. There are a number of options available both on and off-street for long stay parking.

COUNCIL CAR PARKS

Council provides off-street parking at several locations:

- TAFE Carpark – Corner Barwon and Doyle Street
- Narrabri Region Visitor Information Centre and Crossing Theatre – Tibbereena Street
- Narrabri Aquatic Centre – Tibbereena Street

KEY PARKING SIGNS

There are many different parking restriction signs. Some common signs and their meanings are listed below.



Parking time limits apply as indicated on the sign



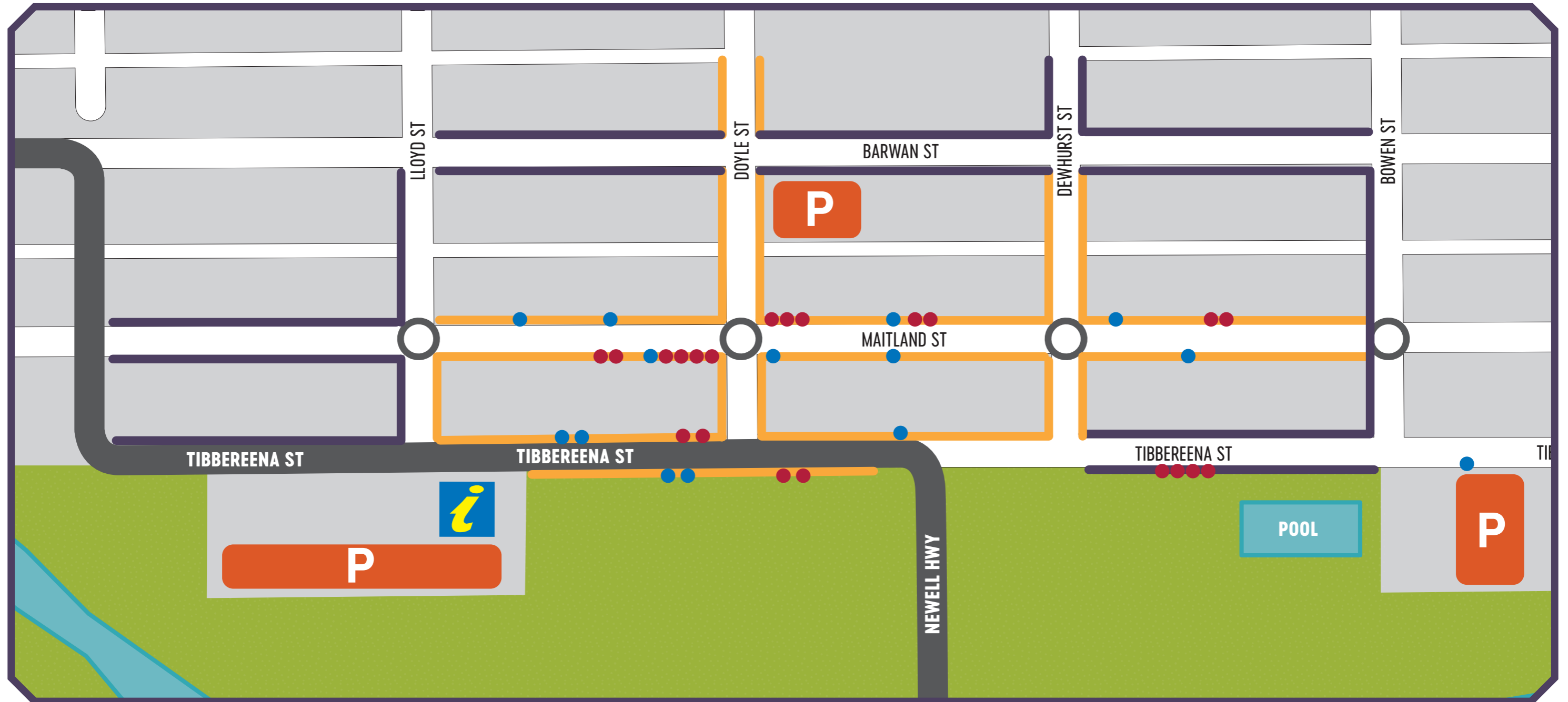
A driver must not stop on a length of road to which a no stopping sign applies. Alternatively, there may be a yellow edge line which also means no stopping. These lines are generally used on their own and in some instances have been used together with the no stopping signs.

Unless otherwise signed, vehicles may stop in a loading zone for up to 2 minutes if dropping-off/ picking-up passengers or for up to 20 minutes when dropping-off/ picking-up goods.
